



## **2010—2011 Brochure for MTCSOL Program ( with Confucius Institute Scholarship ) at Soochow University**

Soochow University is a key comprehensive university of Jiangsu Province and a key university of the “211 Project” of the nation. The university is launching the 2010 “Master of Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages” Program (with Confucius Institute Scholarship) towards international students home and abroad.

### **Introduction**

To encourage the growth of Chinese language all around the world, Hanban and Headquarters of Confucius Institute have set up “Confucius Institute Scholarship (for non-native Chinese teachers)”. From the fall of 2009, they jointly offer the scholarship to students working for Master of Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL).

### **Coverage and Standard of the Scholarship**

1. Students are exempt from registration fee, tuition fee, fees for internship, and fees for basic learning materials;
2. On-campus accommodation. (The university will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by family members or visitors.);
3. Living allowance: 1700RMB/Month;
4. A one-off settlement subsidy after registration: 1500 RMB/Person;
5. Comprehensive medical insurance which covers a large percentage of outpatient medical expenses.

### **Details of Studies**

1. Full-time program
2. All courses are to be taught in mandarin Chinese;
3. Duration: 2years, with 1.5 years coursework and 0.5 year internship either in China or in home country;
4. The degree of Master of Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages is to be granted upon completion of required credits, education internship, thesis and successful thesis defense.



**Qualifications:**

1. Non-Chinese in nationality, under the age of 45;
2. Devoted to Chinese language teaching, and commit to working in 5 years after graduation in the field of Chinese teaching, which could be implemented in all forms;
3. Bachelor-degree holder or above with major in Chinese Language and other humanistic and social scientific disciplines;
4. With high language proficiency and rich knowledge in Chinese culture;
5. With teaching potentials.

Spring Admission: Feb. 2010; Fall Admission: Jul. 2010  
The registration date is subject to the Letter of Admission.
